**CARLOS FELIPE** will speak to the question of "the difference that makes the difference" in therapeutic conversations. Research conducted on the collaborative creative process between therapist and clients will be examined in this segment of the workshop.

**JEANNETTE SAMPER** will present her clinical work with a family struggling with the effects of incest. A Narrative and Collaborative approach was employed and ideas were developed to create an ethnic, sacred space where it was possible to speak of the unspoken. Themes of Machismo and gender differences were at the center of the work with the family.
