**HYBRID FORMAT ELECTIVE**

We are offering elective courses this Fall in hybrid format. A hybrid course combines online learning with a residential session schedule different from the traditional residential courses that meet once a week throughout the trimester. Hybrid courses may include sessions on select weekends or sessions that meet more intensively for one or two weeks. Hybrid courses enable us to offer courses at times that may be more convenient for some students, to bring in visiting professors who may be otherwise occupied during the trimester, and allows some of our distance students to participate in residential classes. Please read the course description and note the dates the class will meet residentially. Attendance at these residential sessions is mandatory.

**MACS/CARM/D 6639- Organizational Conflict**

This course will explore the diagnostic techniques and tools necessary to assess organizational conflict, and tools necessary for successful intervention. Offered yearly.
