Driving Directions to NSU'S Main Campus

From I-95 or Florida's Turnpike

Exit at I-595, proceed west to University Drive exit. Turn left (south) onto University Drive. Proceed approximately 1 ½ miles to SW 30 Street (Abe Fischler Blvd.), turn left (east). NSU's main campus will be on the right side.

From University Drive

From North of I-595

Take University Drive south 1 ½ miles past I-595 to SW 30 Street (Abe Fischler Blvd). Turn left (east). NSU's main campus will be on the right side.

From South of Griffin Road

Take University Drive north approximately 2 miles past Griffin Road to SW 30 Street (Abe Fischler Blvd.). Turn right (east). NSU's main campus will be on the right side.

From I-75

From Miami heading north or west coast/Naples heading east

Merge onto I-595 eastbound (towards Fort Lauderdale). Exit at University Drive exit, turn right (south). Proceed approximately 1 ½ miles on University Drive to SW 30 Street (Abe Fischler Blvd.), turn left (east), go to College Avenue and turn right. NSU's main campus entrance will be on the right side. Go around the circle and just past the Horvitz Administration Building, turn into the parking lot.

To Access the Maltz Building

From University Drive, turn onto SW 30 Street, travel east. After passing the Miami Dolphins Training Camp on your right side, take the fourth entrance into the main campus on your right side. Go straight and turn left at the stop sign. The Maltz Building will be the first building on your left. Make the left turn into the parking lot (the gate arm will automatically raise). Please place the attached parking pass on your dashboard, so you will not get a parking ticket.

Directions to the Parking Garage:

**From I-95, North or South, or Florida's Turnpike,
North or South:**

- Take I-595 exit, westbound.
- Proceed on I-595 to University Drive.
- Turn left and proceed southbound on University Drive to SW 30th Street.
- Turn left onto SW 30th Street and proceed East approximately ½ mile, turn right onto Ray Ferrero, Jr. Boulevard.
- Make a right turn into the NSU campus onto Ray Ferrero, Jr. Boulevard and enter the parking garage using the east side entrance.
- **Park on the 2nd floor and above.**
- If you park on the 1st floor of the garage you will have to Pay for parking even if you have this pass and it is a \$1.00 an hour.

Directions to the Maltz Building Lot:

**From I-95, North or South,
or Florida's Turnpike,
North or South:**

- Take I-595 exit, westbound, proceed on I-595 to University Drive;
- Turn left and proceed southbound on University Drive to SW 30th Street.
- Turn left onto SW 30th Street and proceed to make a right at the entrance east of Ray Ferrero Blvd.
- Turn right onto the end of the road and turn left. The Maltz Building parking gates will be just ahead.
